

District #18 Club Council

By-Laws

1. Robert's Rules of Order shall govern the parliamentary proceedings of this organization unless otherwise provided for in these by-laws. The order of business shall be:
 - A. Roll call
 - B. Reading of minutes of previous meeting
 - C. Report of officers including financial status
 - D. Unfinished business
 - E. New business
2. District #18 Club council annual dues shall be \$25.00 for clubs and \$50.00 for promoters. These are due and payable at the Annual Pre-Sanction Meeting for the coming year. Any club/promoter behind in their dues shall lose their voting power.
3. No parent organization (any organization with more than one (1) chapter) may hold more than one (1) membership in District #18 Club Council, with all branches of that parent organization falling under the same charter.
4. All bills must be accompanied by receipts and will be checked and approved by the Executive Board before they are paid. The only exception will be to allow the Treasurer to disburse up to two hundred fifty (\$250.00) pre month (maximum) as needed to anyone for club business, per his/her own judgment, without board approval.
5. A **\$4.00** per paid entry for MX Point's Championship Series events, **\$2.00** per paid entry for TT Point's Championship Series events, and \$.50 for all other events shall be paid to District 18 Club Council following each event.
6. A copy of the referee report shall accompany this payment and must be received by the Competition Division Chairman within two weeks of the event date. An electronic copy of the results must be received by the point keeper within one week of the event date. A late fee of \$25 per week will be charged for delinquency.
7. \$.20 per paid entry shall be deducted from payments from each event for the Congress Delegate Fund. Each of the delegates may share this fund for travel, meal, lodging, and associated expenses incurred while attending AMA Congress.
8. All officers of District #18 Club Council must be AMA members in good standing.

9. Should the President vacate his office, his duties shall be immediately assumed by the Vice President.
10. All active members of the Club Council shall be members of, or Chartered by the AMA
11. Impeachment procedures may be initiated against any District Officer for:
 - A. Refusal to maintain membership in AMA
 - B. Any conduct determined, by majority vote of the active members present, to be detrimental to District #18 Club Council or the AMA.
12. Expulsion procedures may be initiated against any member of this Club Council for:
 - A. Failure to pay dues or fees within thirty (30) days of established payment dates.
 - B. Refusal to maintain membership in AMA
 - C. Any conduct determined, by majority vote of the active members present, to be detrimental to District #18 Club Council or the AMA.
13. In either case, charges must first be made in writing and the accused given a hearing before the Executive Board. The Executive Board will take all evidence and report its findings to the Club Council with a recommendation stating that either the charges are considered proven and that the accused be impeached or expelled, or that all charges be dropped. The Club Council will then vote on that recommendation and it will require a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the active members present and entitled to vote to veto the recommendation of the Executive Board.
14. The by-laws may be amended or added to by a three quarters (3/4) vote of the active members in good standing present, provided that notice of the proposed amendment be sent to all members at least one (1) week before the meeting and provided that such amendments in no way supersede or contradict the constitution or by-laws of the AMA.
