

## **District #18 Club Council**

### **Code of Ethics**

In order to establish a successful working relationship between the American Motorcyclist Association (AMA) and District #18 Club Council, both parties have agreed upon the same goals and objectives as set forth in this Code of Ethics. The purpose of District #18 Club Council shall include, as stated in the AMA's code of regulations, "to serve the interests of motorcyclist by pursuing, promoting, and protecting the future of motorcycling."

However, it is not sufficient to pursue only the interests of motorcyclists. We must exist in two worlds: motorcycling and non-motorcycling.

Therefore, to assist District #18 Club Council in productive coexistence within the motorcycling and non-motorcycling communities, the following Code of Ethics has been established.

1. District #18 Club Council shall promote good public relations through their general conduct, the media, the internet, district activities, and community affairs.
2. District #18 Club Council shall respect the rights of all Council members and members of the surrounding communities.
3. District #18 Club Council shall abide by all local, state, and federal laws.
4. District#18 Club Council shall strive to promote peaceful and cooperative coexistence with motorcycle clubs and other organizations of the communities.
5. All formal AMA sanctioned activities will be conducted in accordance with all current rules as set forth in the current AMA rule books. All informal activities shall be conducted according to the spirit of this Code of Ethics both within the motorcycling community and the communities at large, and as not to bring any discredit to District #18 Club Council or the AMA.
