

Want To Race?

Thinking about getting into the world of off road racing? AMA District 18 offers a wide variety of off-road riding disciplines. We offer championship series in Motocross, ATV Motocross, TT/Flat Track, and Hare Scrambles. District 18 hosts a National Enduro and a National Dual Sport ride. We also have clubs offering trail riding events and off-road poker runs.

To compete in our events you will need to be a member of the American Motorcycle Association (AMA). Riders may join the AMA at the first event you attend or go to <http://www.ama-cycle.org/> and click the Join/Renew link. To participate in one of the District 18 Championship series, look up the schedule and classes for the series on the District 18 web-site. <http://www.district18racing.net/> Find the class that you will ride and make sure you meet the requirements of that class before you go to your first race. Each class has a short description next to it, but you can find more information on each class in the AMA rule book located on the AMA web-site at: <http://www.ama-cycle.org/rulebooks/> You will need to know the rules in the AMA rule book and the District 18 supplemental rules.

Knowing these rules ahead of time will be of great benefit to you and make your participation in the sport much more enjoyable.

You may want to buy a District card but it is not required. If you participate in District 18 series events you are eligible for points in that series whether you have a District card or not. Buying a district card will not reserve your riding number. You may run any number you wish. Rider numbers are entered at each event on a first come first serve basis. If someone has already entered in your class with your number, you may be asked to change or slash your number. Most of the time this is done by using tape to place a slash across your number. Other AMA Districts may require you to have a district card to participate in their events.

At the end of each year District 18 holds an awards banquet. Anyone may attend this banquet and any rider participating in the minimum number of events, for any of our points championships, will receive an award based on their final outcome along with many attendance prizes at the banquet.
